What it means to you	<u>Rabies:</u> CDPH has authority to <u>collect rabies vaccination</u> information if <u>local/</u> <u>county ordinances</u> are in place to allow it. In addition, dog bites should be reported to your local <u>public health official</u> . <u>Medical Waste Management:</u> Medical waste (biohazardous, pharmaceutical, pathology, trace chemotherapeutic, and sharps waste must be <u>managed in</u> <u>accordance with the law</u> . Most practices use a state-approved <u>medical waste</u> <u>hauler</u> to dispose of waste, although in-house treatment and disposal systems are permitted by contacting your <u>county</u> . The Medical Waste Management Division can inspect premises for public health violations
