Legal Authority	 <u>Rabies Laws and Regulations</u> <u>California Medical Waste Management Act</u> <u>Radiation Regulations (California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Chapter 5, Subchapter 4</u> 	
What it means to you	Rabies: CDPH has authority to collect rabies vaccination information if <u>local/</u> <u>county ordinances</u> are in place to allow it. In addition, dog bites should be reported to your local <u>public health official</u> . <u>Medical Waste Management</u> : Medical waste (biohazardous, pharmaceutical, pathology, trace chemotherapeutic, and sharps waste must be <u>managed in</u> <u>accordance with the law</u> . Most practices use a state-approved <u>medical waste</u> <u>transporter</u> to dispose of waste, although in-house treatment and disposal systems are permitted by contacting your <u>county</u> . The Medical Waste Management Division can inspect premises for public health violations. You must <u>register</u> as a Small Quantity Generator with the program. <u>Radiologic Health Branch</u> : <u>registers radiation producing machines</u> , <u>writes</u> <u>regulations</u> pertaining to radiation safety, and inspects practices for compliance.
