What it means to you	Rabies: CDPH has authority to collect rabies vaccination information if local/county ordinances are in place to allow it. In addition, dog bites should be reported to your local <u>public health official</u> . Medical Waste Management: Medical waste (biohazardous, pharmaceutical, pathology, trace chemotherapeutic, and sharps waste must be <u>managed in accordance with the law</u> . Most practices use a state-approved <u>medical waste transporter</u> to dispose of waste, although in-house treatment and disposal systems are permitted by contacting your <u>county</u> . The Medical Waste Management Division can inspect premises for public health violations. You must <u>register</u> as a Small Quantity Generator with the program.
